ACCA Syllabus

To start at fundamental skills level you will need to have completed AAT level 4 or ACCA fundamentals knowledge level (AB, FM, FA (formerly F1, F2, F3))

In order to become a member you must also complete an ethics self-completion module and a Practical Experience Record (PER) that details at least three years of practical experience. See the ACCA website for further details.

Testing

Each subject is tested by a three hour computer based examination with a pass mark of 50%. Exams are booked with ACCA at one of their centres with sittings in December, March, June and September.

We alternate fundamental papers so that all students can qualify in just over three years ie we will offer TX (Dec 22 sitting), PM (Mar 22 sitting) & LW (Jun 22 sitting) in 2022/23.

Fees include tuition, study text, exam practice kit, training materials, practice tests and a marked mock assessment.

ACCA membership (£112 with an initial registration fee of £89), exemption fees and exam entry fees (standard entry £123 - £222 dependent on subject) are payable directly to ACCA in addition to this.
