Parent Portal is actively being developed and new features will be added in the future.


It is important that you check the available information and attendance data regularly to help enable us to support your son or daughter to progress, achieve and exceed their potential.





How to sign up


To sign up to the Huish Hub Parent Portal website go to https://parenthub.huish.ac.uk/



Select 'Register as a new user'



On the window that pops up, use the drop down to specify if you are the student's Parent, Guardian or Carer.



Please complete the form that appears.

It is important that you carefully and accurately enter your son or daughter's Student ID number.

This can be found on their Student ID card.


Once your data has been submitted and the information provided has been verified, you will receive an email from hub@richuish.ac.uk to confirm your Username and Password. Please note this can take up to 3 working days.

Once you have received your Account Activated email you can access your personal Parent Portal dashboard, by going to https://parenthub.huish.ac.uk/ and log in using your Username and Password.

Dashboard Overview


Once you have logged in you will see the screen below, your dashboard homepage.

- 1. The left panel shows a list of any students you have access to. You can click on their name or photo to go to their student profile.
- 2. The middle panel features the latest college news and important information. This is updated daily, in addition to this you can also visit our social media accounts for frequent news and updates.
- 3. The college calendar on the right panel is updated regularly and contains key dates such as term times and consultation evenings.



Student Profile - Details

By clicking on your son or daughter's photo a window will load containing their personal profile.




This profile contains information on the details we hold about them, the courses they are enrolled on, their college classes, timetable, attendance, exam results on entry to the college and exams they are entered for.

Each of these sections can be accessed by clicking on the tabs along the top of the profile.

The student profile page gives you some additional information about your son or daughter such as their Tutor's name and their college email address. If you notice that any information such as next of kin is out of date or incorrect please contact cis@richuish.ac.uk who will be happy to help with amending this information.


Student Profile - Classes

The Classes tab gives you a list of the courses your son or daughter is currently enrolled on at college.




Student Profile - Timetable

The Timetable tab gives you an overview of your son or daughter's timetable of study for the current academic year. Hovering over the block will provide more information.




Student Profile - Attendance

The attendance tab gives you an overview of your son or daughter's attendance from when they joined college as well as a weekly summary at the bottom of the screen.



Student Profile - Exam Results

The exam results tab gives you a summary of exam results on entry to the college and results attained while at college.



Student Profile - Exam Entries

The exam entries tab shows a summary of any exams your son or daughter has been entered for, with details such as the exam date and start time.



Student Profile - Progress Review

The Progress Review tab gives you an overview of your son or daughter's progress from when they joined college.

Guide to Progress Grades:

Target grade – an aspirational grade for students to aim for, which is based on their prior attainment in that subject, usually GCSEs.

Current working grade – the grade students are currently working at in each subject.

Projected grade – the grade students are most likely to achieve in each subject as their final result next Summer. These will be included on a student's next Progress Review point, after Formal Assessments have taken place.

UCAS Predicted grade – an aspirational grade that students have the potential to achieve in each subject. This is often set higher than their projected grade, given that it is common practice to select an insurance university choice and that it is not uncommon for universities to set entry requirements slightly higher than they ultimately accept in the Summer.
