

Parent/Carer Update - Week commencing 5th October 2025

College Monitoring Point

At key points in the year, we report on student progress – we call these College Monitoring Points (CMPs) – see the [Year 1/Level 2](#) and [Year 2](#) Roadmaps for future CMPs. Level 2, Year 1 and Year 2 students have just **had a RAG rating** to give an indication as to how well they are getting on in relation to their attendance, Huish 30 completion, classroom engagement, and behaviour.

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In addition, Year 2 students have been set their UCAS grade. The UCAS grade is the grade that a teacher judges a student could achieve in the best-case scenario. It's really important to note that this is generally not reflective of how well a student is currently doing, and it will require continued commitment and hard work to get there.

The next CMP will be in December and will give a more accurate reflection of student performance. To view the CMP, access the [Parent Hub](#) or ask your young person to show you on their Hub.
