What have we been up to?

We've been really busy in the Visual Arts Department over the last few months. Our students across Fine Art, Graphic Communication and Photography have been creating outstanding work and have impressed us with their hard work and dedication to refine their work to an impressive, sophisticated and professional level.

We've had an amazing success of our students taking part in the The National Gallery Articulation Prize 2026. Over 1000s young people deliver a 10-minute illustrated presentation to an audience about a work of art, artefact or architecture of their choice in a museum or gallery setting. Our Huish finalist made the cut and will be heading to the National Gallery soon to deliver their speech in person to a panel of esteemed judges.

The majority of our year 2 students that have applied for creative course have been accepted to their choice universities and are now starting the exciting process of finalising their coursework portfolios in readiness of submission and our end of year exhibition.

We just installed three outside visual display screens that will act as an in Huish public Gallery. This will allow our students work to be presented all year round and allow the whole college to enjoy frequent exposure to our outstanding visual artwork.

Recently in lessons we have been ...

Our year 1 Fine Art students have been taking part in a course of life drawing sessions where they have been able to develop and extend their portraiture project through observational studies in a professional setting.

Graphic Communication year 1 students are just about to complete a Live project Brief set by a contact at Graphic Packaging (an international packaging company). Students have been given the task to create a premium product packaging concept for 'Co-Op Irresistible' range. We have had some outstanding examples of work that have impressed professionals within the industry.

Photographers have been experimenting in the photography studio exploring professional standard lighting and equipment. Many students have been excited to explore fashion photography and have been developing their use of composition and technical skills.
